

# How much is the training in the university?

## do my homework cheap

Good day, dear reader! If you read this article, then you are probably interested in the following question: "How much is your training in the university"? It is clear that it is impossible to definitely say about the "price tag" for higher education in Russia today. Yes, it should not be done. This article provides only exemplary figures, which, however, can say a lot about the expediency of learning at the university. So, if you want to get a higher education if you are tormented by a question "Is it worth a heater?", If you are interested in knowing how much (at least approximately), higher education will cost, then this article is written specifically for you.

In addition, if you do not find the answer to the question, let's say, about the total cost for the entire period of study, this is fraught with monetary problems in the future. Correctly, why act thoughtless? You must first collect maximum information, and even then make decisions about the start of learning in one or another educational institution. That's why this article was written.

How much is the training in the university?

Immediately note that this article is designed to a greater extent on those who are going to receive a higher education in full-time education. If you want to get an education on a correspondence form, then all the numbers are divided by 2. Then you will receive an approximate real picture of your costs for higher education.

Lose half a million over 5 years

500,000 rubles - the average cost of higher vocational education in Russia. This number is quite and very conditional, because in essence, it is taken from the comprehensive cost of training in some leading universities of the country + the cost of training in the "medium" in the prestigiousness of universities + the cost of training in little-known universities + the cost of training in branches of universities.

In this article, you will not find any mention of some particular university or institute. This is done deliberately so that no one is offended by any university to prestigious, and the other to the "average".

Half a million rubles is, as I said, the number is very abstract. As you understand, it all depends on the specialty chosen by you, the level of prestigidity of the university and, accordingly, its location. The cost of learning depends on these factors. For example, if you take the same specialty in different universities, you can just find a gigantic abyss in the cost of training.

Sometimes it reaches over 1,000,000 rubles! This is not a joke, it's a fact. At the same time, both

universities are state and work according to a unified state program.

So, in fact, people overpay money for the brand. Of course, in large universities, sometimes the conditions of learning are equally different from the conditions of training in the province. However, all this is also very conditional. Internet today equalizes. Virtually any information can be found on the unstash of the World Wide Web. There would be a desire.

So, if you have an extra million, you can study in the brand university, if not - learn from the Municipal State University, and do not worry the "prestigiousness" of the place of your studies. Anyway, it all depends only on you, from your ability to find simple solutions in difficult situations.

You need to spend another million, or even a half!

Just we figured out the approximate number of the cost of learning in the university. She, as you remember, today is about 500,000 rubles for the entire period of study. However, as you understand, in addition to costs directly at the training itself, you will also spend your own (or not your) money on the road to your school, for food, perhaps for the hostel (removable apartment).

It seems that the amount spent by the student per day is quite small. On average, today the student spends 500 rubles per day. If a given number is multiplied by the tutorial at the university (5 years), then approximately it turns out (without summer vacation) about 500,000 - 700 000 rubles. However, this figure is very and very underestimated. You yourself live for more than one year and perfectly understand that "unforeseen expenses" on our lives are constantly in our lives, the second, third, etc.

In addition, you must take into account the fact that during training in the university, you will not be able to fully work (I mean students of the full-time department). Even if you take the minimum wage of a simple worker on average in Russia (about 15,000 rubles), it turns out about 750,000 rubles for 5 years. These are the lowest money that you lose if you study full-time. Yes, the student today is expensive. What did you want!:) )

What happens in the end? As a result, we have the following:

- 1) Training fee: 500,000 rubles.
- 2) fee for student life: 1,000,000 rubles.
- 3) Losses due to the inability to work fully: 750 000 rubles.

Total: 2 250 000 rubles.

A good one comes out in the end. It seems fantastic, but the truth is true. Of course, those 750,000 rubles which you could earn are not direct training costs. However, these are also costs, although, to

some extent, phantom.

However, even without them it turns out that today to study at the Institute for 5 years it is necessary to spend about 1,500,000 rubles. It's a lot or a little - to solve you. If you are hard to understand a lot or a little, then do the following. Just count how much time you can "repel" data costs. Take the average salary of specialists from your profile and by disadvantaged transformations get an approximate number of months for which you can block your education costs.

Example. You want to become a financier. How much does this specialist get per month? We go to the Internet and type "Salary of Financier". The numbers are certainly widely vary. Take the wages of the financier on average in a major city. This is about 70,000 rubles per month.

Question: For how many months do you pay for your education? We divide the cost of training on the average salary per month:  $2\,250,000 / 70,000 = 33$  months or almost 3 years. Here we will not take into account inflation. We most importantly understand whether it is worth the heater? In this case, the heater is the dressing, in my opinion, still stands.

However, there was an example with a financade. This is a rather highly paid specialist. And if you take other professions, say, doctors or teacher. Of course, there and the costs of training will be smaller, but the average salary check will be no any. 30 000 - 35 000 rubles. - The average salary of the teacher in a major city, and that far - far from everyone.
